TASTING NOTES:

Malbec is a variety which is usually found in blends where it adds lifted fruit aromas and softness to the wine.

In Langhorne Creek it performs extremely well on its own and Bleasdale has been producing a varietal Malbec since 1961.

The 2002 Malbec shows the usual rich plummy fruit flavours and fragrant spiciness, along with a smooth supple palate making it delightful drinking with a smoked rack of lamb over the next 4 or 5 years.
