26% Malbec
20% Shiraz
13% Merlot
9% Petit Verdot

WINE REGION:

Langhorne Creek, South Australia

ALCOHOL:

14.0%

TASTING NOTES:

A blend produced entirely from premium Langhorne Creek grapes. The Cabernet imparts typical regional eucalypt and mint flavours with spices and plums being contributed by the other varieties.

Premium French and American oak barrel maturation has added rich vanillin overtones to the blend and ensured sufficient complexity to allow bottle ageing to improve the wine until about the year 2006.
